All Are Welcome: Bishop Anthony Chirayath of the Diocese of Sagar, India will be doing a presentation on Divine Mercy at Blessed Sacrament Parish on Sunday, May 23, 2010 at 3:00 pm. Bishop Anthony Chirayath is visiting the Diocese of Great Falls-Billings from May 21-31, 2010. Our two dioceses have partnered together and we currently have two priests from India serving parishes in eastern Montana -- Fr. Jolly Pathiyamoola in Wibaux at St. Peter and St. Philip parishes and Fr. Alex Pulickaparambil in Miles City at Sacred Heart Parish. Msgr. Anthony Chirayath was elected as the 3rd Bishop of Sagar on February 2, 2006 by Pope Benedict XVI. The heart of Sagar eagerly welcomed its first son to be its Shepherd. On March 25, 2006, Feast of the Annunciation, the people witnessed one of the best events in the history of the Sagar Diocese. Msgr. Anthony Chirayath was ordained Bishop in a Divine Liturgy concelebrated by 25 Bishops and 250 Priests, in the presence of more than 500 Religious Nuns and nearly 5,000 people. Anthony Chirayath was the first Diocesan priest of Sagar, the first Diocesan Bishop of Sagar and the first Diocesan Bishop of North Indian Syro-Malabar Dioceses. Bishop Chiravath speaks several Indian and European languages. He has travelled widely representing his Office and the Holy See at several international and national meetings.
